Poetry Collection: perhaps experimenting with different forms	Journalistic essay: writing about an issue/event you have researched	Polemic: a persuasively argued piece about something you believe in
Biography/Autobiography: a engaging life story, bringing fiction features to real life	Personal essays: primarily there to entertain and build relationship with a reader	Instructional writing: such as recipes or 'how-to' guides - can genre-blend to create innovative short writing pieces
